

STUDENT USE OF CELLULAR TELEPHONES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES

The Board recognizes that many students possess cellular telephones and other electronic devices. These devices may not be used in any manner that disrupts the educational process or violates Board policies or school rules. M.S.A.D. #70 is not responsible for the damage, loss, or theft of such devices. The Superintendent is authorized to develop, with input from administrators, procedures and/or school rules necessary to implement this policy. These procedures/school rules will be communicated to students and parents through the student handbook and/or student code of conduct.

Exception will be made for students who are fire or rescue volunteers. Phones or pagers will be on vibrating mode.
